The course combines a comprehensive introduction to theology with the practical aspects of catechesis so theory is related to practice all the way through the course.

PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

Eleven modules are studied over two years:

Year 1

- Introduction to Church History
- The Church
- Ways of Praying

Year 2

- Old Testament
- New Testament
- Liturgy and Sacraments A & B
- Life in Christ
- Mary in the Mystery of Christ and the Church

- The Catechism of the Catholic Church
- Access to the Documents of Vatican II

ASSESSMENT

A written assignment is submitted for each module, comprising of a short essay and an outline plan for a catechesis session.
