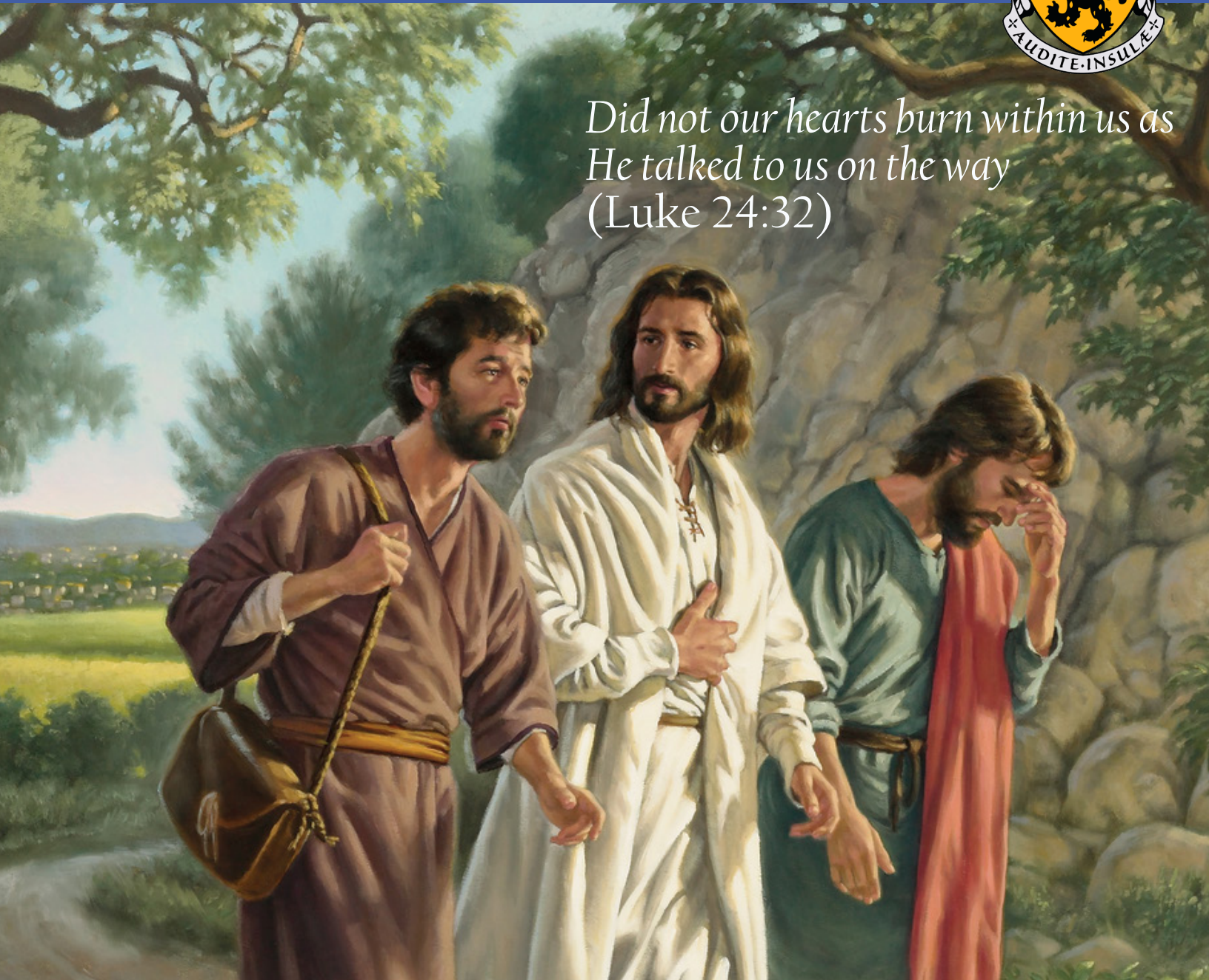

This popular two-year, part-time, distance-learning course, is used by many dioceses around the world for the training of parish catechists, as well as by individuals seeking adult faith formation.

The course combines a comprehensive introduction to theology, with the practical aspects of catechesis, so theory is related to practice all the way through the course.

STRUCTURE OF THE COURSE

Eight modules are studied over two years:

Year 1

- Formation in Faith
- Jesus the Christ
- Introduction to Church History
- The Church

Year 2

- Sacred Scripture
- Liturgy & Sacraments
- Life in Christ: Catholic Moral Teaching
- Ways of Praying

RESOURCES NEEDED

- A Bible
- The Catechism of the Catholic Church
- Access to the Documents of Vatican II

ASSESSMENT

A written assignment is submitted for each module, comprising of a short essay and an outline plan for a catechesis session.
